







And all the people crowded around Jeremiah in the house of the Lord.






31 At that time some Pharisees came to Jesus and said to him, "Leave this place and go somewhere else. Herod wants to kill you."




**Lord's Prayer** *Matthew 6:9-13, LSB 179* **P** Lord, remember us in Your kingdom and teach us to pray:
